Instructions/Housing Bureau Policy

1. Reservations will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. All reservations are subject to 15% tax.
3. All reservations require a deposit of first night's room and tax. Credit card deposits will be held by the hotels as a room guarantee. First night's charge will not be run on credit card.
4. A cancellation fee of \$35.00 will be charged for all rooms cancelled after October 1, 2009. All changes or cancellations prior to 10/21/09 should be made with the Anaheim Housing Bureau. Cancellations or changes made after 10/22/09 must be made directly with the hotels. Rooms cancelled less than 72 hours prior to arrival may be charged a first night room rate plus tax.
