




## To help manage the container lifecycle from import to export.

There's a fee for not picking up containers on time and another for taking too long to return it.








- Container provider diverts equipment from its original location without 48 hours' notice; Loaded container is not available for pick-up upon the motor carrier's arrival;
- Terminal is too congested to accept a container;
- When a motor carrier documents unsuccessful attempts to make appointments;
- Receiving date changes for the booked vessel.






#### **CONTAINER VOLUME IN TEUS FROM JAN. 2022 TO AUG. 2022 IN SELECTED PORTS**






#### AVERAGE D&D CHARGES AFTER 14 DAYS FOR STANDARD CONTAINER IN THE US - 2022









