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

North Amer. Revenue Moves: Yr/Yr % Change








### IMPORTS STABLE IN JUNE AT DEPRESSED LEVEL EXPORTS DROPPED IN APRIL & STAYED DOWN

#### North America Loaded TEUs (000)







U.S. West Coast: Share of N.A. Import TEU



IPI TEUs vs. Import TEUs




IPI + SoCal Transload TEUs vs. Import TEUs


### INTERMODAL TRAIN SPEEDS HAVE DECLINED BUT PICTURE REMAINS FAVORABLE




- Average speed most recent week: 31.5 mph

## AAR WEEKLY DATA INDICATES THE RALLY CONTINUED INTO JULY







# GENERAL OUTLOOK - NO CHANGE UNCERTAINTY RULES!

#### **Pros**

- Freight volumes appear strong across the board
- Government support has kept incomes reasonably level
- Money to spend but no services to spend it on.
   Therefore, more "stuff" bought = more freight

#### Cons


- Virus is accelerating
- Government economic support expiring with substantial GOP resistance towards extension and/or disarray in what is should look like
- Expiring PPP = rising unemployment
- Foreclosure and small business bankruptcy waves looming
- Reopening effort slowing/pausing
- Societal fears still high
- Back to school MIA

For me, the balance appears negative. But I didn't see June's freight wave coming either. Caveat Emptor!




# DISSECTING THE DOMESTIC SURGE COMPARE WITH IPI, IMPORT TEUS

Midwest-Northwest Intermodal Volume vs. PNW Import TEUs, 2018 Average = 100






## DRAYAGE DEMAND INDEX SHOWS SOME STRENGTHENING IN SOCAL


