WHAT IS SACP 3.0 AND WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE FROM THE CURRENT SACP?

Changes

SACP 3.0 is the next generation Interoperable Chassis Pool supported by The Georgia Port Authority (GPA), Jacksonville Port Authority (Jaxport), North Carolina State Ports Authority (NC Ports) and the Ocean Carrier Equipment Management Association (OCEMA), an association of 10 major international container carriers, and Consolidated Chassis Management (CCM).

This is being done to increase and upgrade the South Atlantic Chassis Pool (SACP) by introducing 50,000+ new and refurbished, high quality intermodal chassis to handle the international container trade to and from major South Atlantic ports (e.g., Jacksonville, Savannah, and Wilmington NC), as well as key inland intermodal hubs (e.g., Atlanta, Birmingham, and Charlotte).
